







Outside some exclusions and depending on eligibility, students get to choose their double degree combination.



### Admin changes for 2020



- 10 Credit Point System (150 hours of activity)
- Weighted Average Mark replaces Grade Point Average
- Four Alpha/Four Numeric Course Coding System
- Supported by a new Curriculum Management System

### What happens in 2020?



- Where possible students will be moved to the new architecture
- Senate will deem and/or save if necessary
- Why would a student not be moved to the new architecture?




**Outside any University** mandated exclusions, students may choose to enrol in any combination of double postgraduate Masters degree for which they are qualified to enrol.






























# Postgraduate micro-credentials, micro-courses, and continuing professional development



- 1 to 5 credit points
- (15-75 hours)
- Online, blended and/or intensive
- Set commencement dates throughout year





- Recognition of attainment
- Micro-course (non-AQF) awarded on completion of 20 credit points
- "Earned Access" to AQF awards past 20 credit points





### **Curriculum Renewal**



#### ESTABLISHING OUR 2020 COURSEWORK SUITE

- Faculties engaged to tip existing/new courses into the new curriculum architecture
- This activity will run from **25<sup>th</sup> July** to **24<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018**
- Using 2019 course offerings as a baseline, the renewal process will impact:
   96 undergraduate course offerings and 207 postgraduate course offerings
  - 41 x single Bachelors (UG)
  - 45 x double Bachelors (UG)
  - 160 x single Doctors, Masters, Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma (PG)
  - 47 x double Masters (PG)
- The goal is to finalise the list of 2020 course offerings for students

### Preparation



- From 25<sup>th</sup> July the project will commence faculty leadership briefings and training sessions
- The curriculum renewal tool **Course Submission** will be made available on **30<sup>th</sup> July**
- By default, all planned monthly FSQC, ASQC, Academic Senate meetings will continue as the mechanism for approving courses. Additional approval meetings may be added (if required)
- To support the renewal process, **faculties will have access to** 
  - Guidelines (Best Practice and QA)
  - Quality Assurance checklist
  - Training and associated resources
  - Curriculum architecture project team staff
